



## GLOSSARY OF TERMS

NOTE: Please consult your agreement for terms and conditions as they may be different than these listed.

### Computer

Programs licensed for use on a single specified computer.

### Concurrent Devices

The maximum number of input devices accessing the Programs at any given point in time. If multiplexing software or hardware (e.g. a TP monitor, webserver product) is used, this number must be measured at the multiplexing front-end.

### Embedded Software Licenses

An Embedded Software license is a restricted type of license sold with an Application Package. Embedded licenses may only be used by the end-user to execute the Partner's application program. Embedded Software licenses may not be used with more than one Application Package. Oracle considers an Embedded License Application to be an application where the database is truly embedded into the application and the enduser has little or no knowledge that an Oracle database exists in the application. Examples are network management applications, personal use applications, small niche business applications (e.g. dental office scheduling application, auto mechanic billing application, etc.) and applications where the Oracle database is embedded into a physical device (e.g.. PDA's, Internet Pay Phones, Medical Equipment, etc.).

### Application Specific Full Use

An Application Specific Full Use license is a restricted type of license sold with an Application Package. Application Specific Full Use licenses may only be used by the end-user to execute the Partner's application program, as defined in an Application Package Attachment and may not be used with more than one Application Package or with third-party applications. Application Specific Full Use Programs may be used in conjunction with an Application Package that has been modified or customized provided the customizations and modifications remain within the scope of the Application Package.

### Deployment Programs

Programs that may be used only to execute existing applications or reports. They may not be used to build or modify reports or applications. Deployment Programs are to be generated by Customer from Full Use Programs.

### Full Use

Unaltered versions of the Programs with all functions intact.

Full Use licenses are appropriate when:

- a customization or modification is made beyond what is permitted in the Application Package Attachment
- a customer is deploying multiple applications
- a partner is deploying an application that has been developed or customized exclusively for the end-user
- a customer requires an unrestricted license.

### Migration

#### Named User or Developer

An individual who is authorized by Customer to use the Oracle Programs, regardless of whether the individual is actively using Programs at any given time.

#### OPP

OPP has four distinct levels of participation based on partner business needs and commitment to Oracle.
